

## Consent Use Tax Return Information per Internal Revenue Service Rev Proc 2013-14

Federal law requires this consent form be provided to you ("you" refers to each taxpayer if more than one). Unless authorized by law, we cannot use, without your consent, your tax return information for purposes other than the preparation and filing of your tax return.

You are not required to complete this form. If we obtain your signature on this form by conditioning our services on your consent, your consent will not be valid. Your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent will be valid for one year.

For your convenience, we may be able to offer you tax planning and tax saving strategies or ideas or ancillary services. To do this we will need to use the information we obtain during the course of your tax return preparation. **If you sign this form, you are allowing us to use your tax return information gathered in the course of preparing your tax return to provide you with tax planning or tax saving strategies or ancillary services.**
